

OPEN JAR TERRARIUM



This is a fun and easy project for the kids to do using materials that can be found at home.

YOU'LL NEED:

STEPS:

1. Safety is key while handling potting mix so you will need to wear garden gloves and masks.
2. Add small pebbles/rocks to the jar, layering them 2cm high from the bottom.
3. Add in your potting mix using a mini garden spade by filling the jar about half way up.
4. Dig a hole in the soil and plant the succulent.
5. Water your succulent by using a teaspoon full of water.
6. Add in your decorations.
7. Display on a window sill where there will be plenty of sunlight.



Tip:

- For decorations, you can use small toys, figurines, shells, beads, dried herbs or moss.
- Open jar terrariums require sunlight and should be watered sparingly once the soil is completely dry.

All projects should be carried out under competent adult supervision and using appropriate equipment. Ensure garden gloves and mask are worn when handling soil.
