

PAINTING WITH MARBLES



This is a fun and easy project for the kids to do using materials that can be found at home.

YOU'LL NEED:

- Shallow cardboard box or container
- Paper or cardstock
- Poster paint (various colours)
- Egg cartons or old containers
- Old spoons
- Marbles

STEPS:

1. Prep the paint by placing different coloured paint in egg cartons or old containers.
2. Pop the marbles into each paint and mix them around to coat them well.
3. Place the paper/cardstock in the shallow cardboard box/container. Ideally the paper or cardstock should be the same size the box.
4. Using a spoon, place the paint coated marbles onto the paper/cardstock in the shallow box/container.
5. Lift the box/container and start tilting it around. The marbles will create trails of colour and design on the paper.



Tip:

Marble painting creates quirky designs. Be sure to frame your art and gift them as a present to your loved ones. You can also use this as gift paper!

All projects should be carried out under competent adult supervision and using appropriate equipment.
